Accident/ Emergency Procedures

What to do in the event of an emergency, accident, or breakdown

□ Aid the injured. <u>Call 911</u> to request medical assistance, if needed.

ACHD

- Make sure you are in a safe location. Use your judgement as to whether you should remain in the van or move to a safer location near the scene. Place emergency reflective triangles if needed (located in back of van).
- Call 911 if this is an emergency, for medical assistance and to file a police accident report. All accidents involving another vehicle or resulting in personal injuries or property damage must be reported to the Police. (Note: non-emergency contact numbers listed under "Local Law Enforcement" below).
- If this is an accident:
 - Do not admit fault.
 - If another vehicle is involved, follow appropriate procedures, including exchanging insurance information (glovebox).
 - Complete the Vanpool Accident Report Form (glovebox) and return to ACHD Commuteride.
 - Take photos of the damage / scene. Be sure to include photos of all vehicles / property involved.
 - Complete witness statements (there are two in the Accident Report Kit in the glovebox).
 - Do not leave the scene of the accident unless police release you.
- Notify Commuteride of the incident: please leave a detailed voicemail and your call will be returned as soon as possible. All incidents must be reported to Commuteride within 24 hours; serious incidents must be reported immediately.

 - Vanpool members receive \$300 or 6 emergency ride home trips covered by Commuteride. Commuteride may be billed directly for this service.
